

- Is open to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, colour or creed.
- A child must have completed 3 years for LKG Admission on 1st April as minimum age. Admission process for the classes L.K.G. & H.K.G. is done from February 15 to March 15 every year. Admission to remaining seats will be considered only in the month of June depending on vacancies.
- Admission to the other classes is made purely on the basis of an entrance test. Date and time will be mentioned in the notice board. The decision of the Principal in matters of admission is final and binding.
- Recommendation or approach through any source will be disqualification for admission.
- There are No Donation Linked Admissions. Beware of unscrupulous intermediaries who, for their personal gain, offer to intervene on your behalf. You could be deprived of admission of your child as well as your hard earned money.
- A boy/girl who has attended any recognized school will not be admitted with out a school leaving certificate from the same.
- A pupil failing twice in the same class must discontinue his studies in the school.



Discipline

No student can take leave for more than 7 days without prior permission of the principal. In case of long leave due to sickness, a medical certificate should be attached with the leave application. Whenever a student is absent in the school, he/she must write a leave application get is signed by the parent and be produced before the principal for signature.

Students will not be allowed to be taken home during the school hours. In case of emergency, only the parent can take their children home with the permission of the principal. Students will not be sent home with anybody other than parent or guardian.

Tacilities

The students are divided into four houses. Inter house competitions in Debate, Games, Extempore Speech, Dramatics Fancy Dress Competition, Essay Writing, Hand Writing Competition, Cut & Paste Competition, Dance & Singing Competition, Mehndi & Rangoli Competition, Quizzes are conducted. The children also take part in Inter school competitions. From time to time various festivals like Rakhi, Diwali, Christmas and Holi are celebrated in the school campus with zeal and enthusiasm. Every year on the occasion of children's day Bal-mela is organized. The Senior and Junior Literary Societies have their meetings once a week; they organise debate, speeches, drama, quiz and many other competitions. Excursions, Hikes, Holiday Camps and Educational Tours are regular feature and the students are encouraged to take part in them; they enrich the mind and strengthen the body of the student.



Prayer Assembly

The School begins everyday's programme and work with the prayer assembly. It is obligatory for all children to participate in the prayer assembly. The assembly commences with a prayer to the Almighty to shower abundant blessings on the students, staff and parents and on the day's studies and work. During the assembly students are taught how to pray and experience God. Assembly are based on Weekly Theme in which a particular class participate. Acts are displayed in which every student of particular class participates. Moral instructions for character formation is given besides the general announcements.

Visit

Second Saturday of every month is kept as an open day for the parent and guardian, to meet the teachers and discuss the progress of their son/daughter.

No one is allowed to meet the teachers or students during class hours without the written permission of the Principal



Leave

No leave of absence is granted except on a written application from a parent or guardian and that only for serious reasons. A pupil taking leave without the written permission of the Principal may be dismissed from the school forthwith. If a pupil is absent due to sickness, the Principal must be informed at once. When a pupil who has been absent for any reason returns to school, he must bring the excuse duly entered on the Leave Record page of the Diary and signed by the parent or guardian, otherwise the pupil will be refused admission and sent home. In this case the school disclaims all responsibility.

Discipline

TUS's students will be expected to conduct themselves as gentlemen/gentlewomen whether in school or outside. Punctuality and regularity will be instilled in the students from the very beginning.

Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience or conduct injurious to the moral tone of the school are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a pupil. Pupils are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct, both in and outside of school. Hence misbehaviour in public streets and conveyance is liable to incur dismissal. Any breach of discipline and above all discourtesy and disrespect to teachers in any way will be taken seriously and student responsible for such misbehaviour will be summarily dismissed. All students are to abide strictly by the discipline and rules laid down by the school authorities. Use or possession of tobacco, intoxicants and any kind of harmful drugs is strictly forbidden. Electronic equipments, cell phones, transistors, cassettes, cd's, dvd's etc., are not allowed to be brought to the school. Breach of such discipline will entail expulsion from the school. The Principal is fully empowered to rusticate, suspend or take necessary action in case of indiscipline.

Expectations from Parents

We do expect parents:

- To maintain regular contact with the school.
- 2. To check school diary everyday and sign the teachers remarks, if any.
- 3. To encourage the child in the habit of neatness.
- To send leave application and get it prior sanctioned.
- To report the child's absence due to illness or infectious disease at once and send him/her to school only after recovery from illness.
- To encourage the child to speak in English at home.
- 7. To attend the PTA meet regularly.
- To be regular in payments of fee at the prescribed time.
- Not to take the child home during the school hours, (no child will be sent home).
- Not to send the child to school when he/she is suffering from any disease/infection.
- 11. Not to meet the teacher during the school hours directly without prior permission from the principal. No personal phone calls on school related matters and no presents and gifts to teachers.
- 12. Parents visit: Parents/Guardians are requested to visit the school to meet teacher only on second Saturday of the month, at other times, with the prior permission of the principal.

The Curriculum of **TUS** is based on the mantra "Let children be themselves". Here children are not just given wings, but the school also ensures that they develop strong roots. Most importantly, children are loved and made to feel cherished so that they approach life with a positive attitude. To build a competitive mind-set for developing a winning attitude among students, we prepare them NTSE exam along with regular classes as the syllabus of NTSE is based on NCERT class 9 and 10th syllabus. We are also preparing students for Olympiad in Science, Maths, G.K., English and Computer. To ensure children's success in any competitive examination, we have designed our academic programme in a scientific and systematic manner that develops both knowledge and problem solving acumen. To achieve this, we have a team of experienced and most renowned faculty members.

A spacious colourful school with a scientifically planned curriculum and computers opened the eyes of the parents to a new way of bringing up children. Hostel

The hostel is truly a model for nurturing a sound body and steady mind for the students. It is self-sufficient in all respects and geared to take care of every need of the student. The various kind of services provided for the students inside the hostel premises itself are as below:

- Multi-Purpose Hall: The hostel has an airy and versatile hall, which is used for various purposes. It serves
 as a Dining Hall. Prayer Hall as well as a Performance Hall for various extra-curricular and co-curricular
 activities of the hostel.
- Hostel Mess: The hostel mess caters to all the food and nutritional requirements of the students. They are served a well-balanced and strictly vegetarian diet along with milk at the hostel. The menu for all meal sessions is changed regularly to provide variety and wholesome nourishment.
- Medical Facilities: The health of the children is adequately watched over in the hostel. It has a wellequipped dispensary under the care of a professional Medical Practitioner. No stone is left unturned when
 it comes to the physical well being of any child. The students are periodically examined by E.N.T., Eye and
 Dental specialists. Also the services of the General and the Super-Speciality Hospitals, which are located
 in the vicinity, are extended to the inmates of the hostel whenever necessary.
- Sick Ward Pantry: There is also a separate Sick Ward Pantry to prepare special diets as per doctor's advice
 for students not keeping good health.
- Other in-house facilities: The hostel has a number of other services in-house to make the stay of the student at the hostel a pleasant experience. They include - A general stores stocking every possible item, from pencils and pins to buckets and bags, as may be required by the students. A library and reading room with a variety collection of general knowledge and children story books apart from comics and other light reading material.







Dunctuality

A healthy dialogue is established in the parent-teacher meet which is arranged after every assessment. We strongly believe that parents are as important a part of the learning process as the students themselves. Progress report is given four times in a year to show the strength and weakness of the system as marks and ranking fill a child with stress, specially with overbearing parents. For pre-primary no examination. Assessment Report is on the basis of day-to-day assessment.

Students are expected to come to school on time, and must reach the school 10 minutes before the first bell. The school timings are as under:

Pre Primary

Summer: Monday to Saturday - 8:30 am to 1:30 pm Winter: Monday to Saturday - 9:30 am to 2:30 pm

Saturday is a holiday for pre-primary classes, they have a five days school.

Primary to Secondary

Summer: Monday to Saturday - 7:45 am to 1:30 pm Winter: Monday to Saturday - 8:30 am to 2:30 pm

Second saturday shall always be a holiday for all classes (unless the school schedules a celebration,

competition or examination)
